This winery is managed by the four Buoncristiani brothers who were raised in Napa and in the business. The wine is the winery's house red blend. The name is short for "Ol'Pa's Claret," in honor of their winemaking predecessors. The word Claret is often used by the British to denote a Bordeaux. This wine received a 92 point rating in Wine Enthusiast magazine.
